## **Multi-Religious Calendar**

The Campus Christian Center (CCC) cultivates radical hospitality and nurtures spiritual wellness by developing and nurturing an ecumenical Christian atmosphere; and facilitating interfaith education, conversation and engagement (an excerpt, see CCC website for full mission statement).

> **Wednesday, June 16**: MARTYRDOM OF GURU ARJAN DEV SAHIB (**Bahá'í**) The fifth Guru and first martyr of the Sikhs. He compiled the Guru Granth Sahib.

> > Friday, July 9: MARTYRDOM OF THE BÁB (Bahá'í) The date the Báb was executed.

**Tuesday, July 20**\*: EID AL-ADHA (**Islam**) Commemorates Ibrahim's sacrifice of his son to God.

**Saturday, July 24**: ASALHA PUJA (**Buddhism**) Theravada festival celebrating the Buddha's first sermon.

Saturday, July 24\*: TISHA B'AV (Judaism) Day of mourning to commemorate many tragedies that have befallen Jewish people, many occurring on the ninth of Av.

**Sunday, August 15**: FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY (**Christianity/Catholic**) The celebration of Mary's assumption into heaven at the end of her earthly life.

## Thursday, August 19\*: ASHURA (Islam)

Shi'a Muslims commemorate the martyrdom of Husayn ibn Ali, Muhammad's grandson. According to Sunni Muslims, Muhammad fasted and asked others to do so on this day as well.

Sunday, August 29: KRISHNA JANMASHTAMI (Hinduism) Celebration of the birth of Krishna.

\* Denotes holidays that begin at sundown the prior day.
