Current Residence of Berea College Graduates, November 10, 2008

This report describes where our graduates currently reside. On the attached charts, you will see various breakdowns. In these charts, the data are based on 10 years of graduates (Academic Years 1997-98 through 2006-07). We were able to obtain accurate addresses for 92 % of the graduates (2,623/2,844). In-Territory is defined as "Kentucky and parts of eight other states within the south central area of Appalachia."

Below are general highlights of the basic findings.

- Overall, 68% of the graduates currently reside in one of the In-Territory counties; 30% reside Out-of-Territory and 2% live in a foreign country.
- Of all graduates, 45% (N = 1176/2623) live in Kentucky and exactly half of the Kentucky residents live in the eastern part of the state and the other half live in central and western Kentucky. Also, 28% (333/1176) of all Kentucky residents live in Madison County.
- Of those who came from any of the In-Territory counties, 81% currently reside in an In-Territory county.

Overall, the data suggest that the In-Territory area loses, on average, about 14 graduates each year. The <u>net</u> migration out of the In-Territory was 143 graduates for the most recent 10 years of graduates. This figure takes into account the migration *into* the In-Territory region by Out-of-Territory and International graduates.

- Of graduates who came from a foreign country (F-1 International students), 86% (N = 171) currently reside in the United States, 9% returned to their home country and 5% now live in another country. Of those graduates living in the U.S., the largest population is in Kentucky (N = 38) and most live in either Fayette or Madison counties (N = 24).
- Of domestic graduates, 38% returned home to the same county in the same state; 24% returned to the same state but to a different county, and 38% now live in a different state (0.3% live in a foreign country, N = 8).
- Of graduates who came from Kentucky, 78% return to Kentucky and 21% now live in a different state. Four graduates who came from Kentucky now live in a foreign country.
- Of African-American graduates, 67% currently reside in the In-Territory region. Of those who came from the In-Territory region, 83% currently reside there.



• The current residence status of graduates varies depending on their academic stream (i.e., groups of similar majors). As the chart below illustrates, Education and Professional graduates are more likely to return to the In-Territory region than are Mathematics and Science graduates.






Current Residence Status: Breakdown by Entering Territory Designations







Current Residence Status: Breakdown by Entering Territory Designations




Current Residence Relationship with Origin Status Domestic versus International Students









Current Residence Status of African-American Graduates Breakdown by Entering Territory Designations



Current Residence by State and Foreign Country




Current Kentucky Residence by County




Current Residence by State and Foreign Country International Graduates (N = 199)



Current Kentucky Residence by County International Graduates (N = 38)




Current Residence Status Majors by Stream





Current Residence Relationship to Origin Status Majors by Stream






Current Residence Status of Graduates who came from the Out-of-Territory Counties Majors by Stream



Current Residence Status of Graduates who came from Foreign Countries Majors by Stream





Current Residence Status Graduates in the Professional Stream* (N = 782) Breakdowns by Entering Territory Designations





Current Residence Status Graduates in the Humanities Stream* (N = 532) Breakdowns by Entering Territory Designations





Current Residence Status Graduates in the Mathematics and Science Stream* (N = 334) Breakdowns by Entering Territory Designations





Current Residence Status Graduates in the Business Administration Stream* (N = 312) Breakdowns by Entering Territory Designations






Current Residence Status Graduates in the Education Stream* (N = 162) Breakdowns by Entering Territory Designations


