

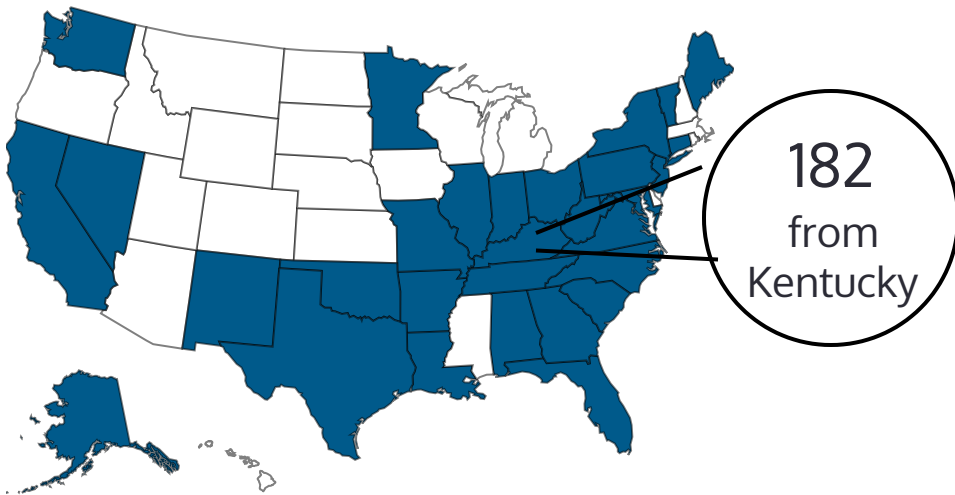

- 30 Countries

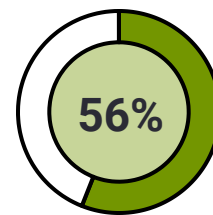
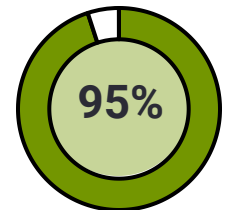
- 66% In-Territory
