## 2018-2019 PEACE AND SOCIAL JUSTICE STUDIES MINOR

(Minimum of five course credits)

A study of the causes of social injustice and violence, and of the conditions and practices necessary for establishing social justice, equality and sustainable peace in every dimension of human life and at every level of human interaction. The minor in Peace and Social Justice Studies requires a minimum of five (5) course credits. Students interested in pursuing an Independent Major in this field of study should contact the Director of Peace and Social Justice Studies to begin working on their proposal as early in their college career as possible.
