2021-2022 ART HISTORY MINOR

(Minimum of five course credits)

A minor in Art History examines the artistic traditions of a broad range of periods and places, and the full spectrum of visual media based on the intersection between Art History and Social History. The minor is designed for flexibility and to complement a student's interests and his or her study pursued in other disciplines.
