## **Auditor Application**

Some students, particularly non-degree seeking students, may wish to audit a course for personal enrichment and for the sake of learning without receiving course credit. To register for an audit, a student must complete all parts of the application below. Auditors are expected to attend class regularly, however the extent to which an instructor grades an auditor's work is determined by mutual agreement between the instructor and the auditor. No grades or credit will be awarded for audited courses.

For community members, auditing a course is \$50 per term (course supplies are additional), and registration is handled through the Office of the Registrar (115 Lincoln Hall). Community members are expected to complete the Audit Application for every term of enrollment.

The decision to grant permission for a community member to audit a course is at the discretion of the instructor and the Office of the Registrar. Permission to audit courses at Berea College may be revoked at any time.

Former Berea College students interested in auditing a course must be in good standing with the College and have no holds on their account.

Community members auditing a course are not provided a laptop during enrollment.
