POLICY FOR GUESTS OF BEREA COLLEGE STUDENTS SPRING 2021 TERM

Following the release of new CDC guidelines in March 2021, beginning Monday, March 29, 2021, Berea College students will have more flexibility to have guests visit them on campus. Intended visitors who are fully vaccinated, including the recommended waiting period according to the administered vaccine, will be able to request campus visits provided they agree to the following process and conditions.

- 1. Student must request an exception for a campus guest to visit them at the following link. https://app.smartsheet.com/b/form/8e4b3200301f40379f7d5b232fe3ab15
- 2. Requests must be made at least 96 hours in advance of the campus visit.
- 3. The student must provide the visitor's documentation of their full vaccination within at least 96 hours of the request being made.
- 4. No more than two guests per student at any one time are permitted.
- 5. Guests will not be allowed in student rooms in Residence Halls.
- 6. Guests will be allowed to visit students in any outdoor spaces as well as in reservable spaces across the campus. Students living in the Ecovillage may be able to host up to two visitors.
- 7. Guests will not be allowed to stay on campus or in the Ecovillage overnight.
- 8. Guests cannot participate in College-sponsored programs unless approved by Student Life or the Administrative Committee in advance.
- 9. When guests arrive on campus, they must check in with Public Safety and provide documentation of vaccination(s) and a picture I.D. Public Safety and/or Student Life will notify the student that one's guest(s) are on campus. Failure to check in will lead to the loss of future visitations.
- 10. Public Safety will inform visitors where to park.

- 12. Guests and students will be expected to wear masks during the visit.
- 13. When the visit is complete, the student will be expected to inform Public Safety of the conclusion of the visit. Failure to report will lead in the loss of future visitations.
- 14. A student who hosts visitors must arrange for testing within five (5) days after the visit and report the results to Student Life.
- 15. Student Life will make any exceptions to this policy.
