HOW TO RECYCLE AT BEREA COLLEGE



Recycling at Berea College is *single-stream*, which means that all items that can be recycled are placed in the same bin. You will see many of these bins on campus, labeled "**MIXED RECYCLING**."

These are items that *can be recycled*:

cardboard • paper • plastic and glass bottles • cans • plastic lids

In addition to recycling, we can also *compost* many things at Berea College,

however, only at events. Composting is a process that breaks down biodegradable items into soil. Berea College compost goes to the Greenhouse and the Farm and is used to grow fresh produce.

These are items that *can be composted*:

plates* • napkins • cups* food scraps *Marked "Compostable" / EarthChoice™ Brand



Items that cannot be recycled or composted will go to a landfill. Please be mindful of



how many of these items you buy and reuse them if you can.

These are items that *cannot be recycled or composted* and must go into the trash:

plastic bags • plastic silverware paper plates • soiled food wrappers
